MARYLAND, That Section 27-7 (a) (1) of Article 33 - Election Code, of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1971 Replacement Volume and 1974 Supplement) be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

Article 33 - Election Code

27-7.

- (a) In sufficient time prior to any election, the boards shall have printed an adequate number of absentee ballots, the three kinds of envelopes described in this section, and the instructions to absentee voters as set out in §27-8 of this article.
- (1) Absentee ballots in the discretion of the board may be in the form either of paper ballots or of one or more punchcards kept together in a covering folder, provided that all absentee ballots in any one county or Baltimore City shall be in the same form. THE FORM AND ARRANGEMENT OF ALL ABSENTEE BALLOTS SHALL BE AS PRESCRIBED BY THE STATE ADMINISTRATIVE BOARD OF ELECTION LAWS.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1975.
