(E) A SNEAK BOAT OR BUSHWACK RIG MAY NOT BE USED WHILE ANCHORED OR MOORED WITHIN LESS THAN 1000 YARDS OF A STOOL OF DECOYS; NOR MAY IT BE USED WHILE ANCHORED WITHIN 500 YARDS OF A LICENSED BLIND OR BLIND SITE, OR ANY OTHER RIG LICENSED FOR HUNTING WILD WATERFOWL.]

(E) IN THE WATERS OF BRANNOCK'S BAY AND TRIPPE'S BAY IN DORCHESTER COUNTY, A PERSON MAY NOT ERECT OR MAINTAIN A STATIONARY BLIND OR BLIND SITE BEYOND A LINE DRAWN FROM HILLS POINT IN A NORTHEASTWARDLY DIRECTION TO THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF WHAT IS KNOWN AS THE GREAT FLATS AND FROM THERE TO WHAT IS KNOWN AS WEIR POINT OR ORCHARD MARSH.
