Crimes and Punishments - Sex Discrimination

FOR the purpose of extending certain provisions of the criminal law now applicable to members of a particular sex to members of both sexes; [[making certain rights and penalties under the bigamy law applicable to both sexes; repealing a certain forfeiture provision under the bigamy law;]] making certain prohibitions, rights and exemptions under the false insignia laws applicable to both sexes and to sororal organizations; extending the crime of pandering to include certain acts done with reference to males; making style changes, deleting obsolete references; repealing references to certain minimum penalties; and relating generally to the application of certain criminal laws to members of both sexes.
