Sales and Notices - State Lottery Tickets Given
in Sales PromotionFOR the purpose of allowing tickets for the State Lottery
to be given away as a part of a sales promotion.

BY repealing and re-enacting, with amendments,

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Section 21D of Article 83 - Sales and Notices, of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1969 Replacement Volume and 1974 Supplement) be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

Article 83 - Sales and Notices

21D.

The notification to any person by any means, as part of an advertising scheme or plan, that he has won a prize, received an award, or has been selected or is eligible to receive anything of value which is conditioned upon his purchasing any item, or submitting to a sales promotion effort constitutes an unlawful practice under this subtitle. The provisions of this section do not apply to trading stamps as defined by § 239(a) of Article 56 of the Annotated Code OR STATE LOTTERY TICKETS ISSUED UNDER THE AUTHORITY OF ARTICLE 88D.]]
