

(a) So much thereof as may be necessary, in addition to the premiums realized from the sale, if any, for the cost of issuance, including the expense of engraving, printing, advertising, attorney's fees, and all other incidental expenses connected therewith; and

(b) The remainder of such proceeds shall be used for the purpose of extending, improving and modernizing the lighting system used for the illumination of the highways, streets, alleys and other public ways in the City of Baltimore, including, but not limited to, the conversion of ornamental incandescent residential street lighting units and facilities to other units and facilities, and the acquisition, installation and erection of any and all materials, equipment, lighting units, structures and facilities needed to properly illuminate the aforementioned public ways, and for doing any and all things necessary, proper or expedient in connection with or pertaining to any or all of the matters or things herein mentioned.

SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety and having been passed by a ye and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly of Maryland, the same shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 349

(Senate Bill 664)

AN ACT concerning

Courts and Judicial Proceedings - Appeals

FOR the purpose of correcting an omission by providing for the appealability of certain additional interlocutory orders; correcting certain nomenclature and a cross-reference; and adding punctuation.

BY repealing and re-enacting, with amendments,
