shall immediately after the first day of January in each year, give a second notice, published as [aforesaid] PROVIDED BY THIS SUBSECTION, notifying the public generally that all taxes which are not paid on or before the first day of February next succeeding the date of [such] THE notice, will be collected by advertisement and sale, as provided for by law. Each of the [said] newspapers [so] designated [as aforesaid] shall be allowed the sum of ten dollars per annum for publishing [the] THESE two [aforesaid] notices.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1975.

CHAPTER 390

(Senate Bill 1105)

AN ACT concerning

Unauthorized Practice of Law

FOR the purpose of including the bar counsel among those persons who may bring a complaint against a person who is engaging in the unauthorized practice of law.
