

(1) In Garrett County (1) the State's Attorney's salary is [seven thousand dollars (\$7,000)] \$7,000. (2) The State's Attorney's allowance for postage, office and travel expenses is a minimum of [six thousand dollars (\$6,000)], and a maximum of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000), provided however that] \$6,000. HOWEVER, any amount in excess of [six thousand dollars (\$6,000)] \$6,000 shall be at the discretion of the Board of County Commissioners. (3) The State's Attorney may appoint an assistant State's attorney to serve at the pleasure of the State's Attorney. The assistant State's attorney's salary is [five thousand dollars (\$5,000) per annum] \$5,000 A YEAR.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1975.

(House Bill 374)

AN ACT concerning

Personal Representatives - Commissions on the
