the fee collected for filing a security interest with the Department of Natural Resources; and relating generally to security interests in vessels.

When a security interest is discharged, the secured party shall securely attach to the certificate of title a release of security interest, in whatever form as may be prescribed by or acceptable to the department, and within 15 days mail or deliver the certificate of title with attached release to the owner and a copy of the release to the department. The department shall correct its records and, upon the request of the owner and the receipt by the department of the certificate of title with attached release, the department may issue a new certificate of title to the owner.]
