perjury: First, in all cases where false swearing would be perjury at common law; secondly, in all affidavits required by law to be taken; thirdly, IN all affidavits to accounts or claims made for the purpose of inducing any court or officer to pass [such] THE accounts or claims; fourthly, IN all affidavits required to be made to reports and returns made to the General Assembly or any officer of the government; fifthly, IN all affidavits or affirmations made pursuant to the Maryland Rules OR MARYLAND DISTRICT RULES.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1975.
