During the period from March through June of each year, the Board of County Commissioners of St. Mary's County, in addition to its functions as now fixed by law, shall be "The Board of Estimates for St. Mary's County." The [director of finance] BUDGET OFFICER shall act as secretary to the Board and shall perform such other functions as the Board may require, including immediate supervision of budget submissions and preparation.
