SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Section 2-309(c) (1) of Article - Courts and Judicial Proceedings, of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1974 Volume and 1974 Supplement) be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

Article - Courts and Judicial Proceedings

2-309.

(c) (1) The Sheriff of Anne Arundel County shall receive a salary of \$17,500. In addition to his salary, the Sheriff shall receive [~~\$145,000~~] [~~[\$154,000]]~~ \$157,000 annually to be used for salaries of deputies and any necessary clerical assistants[; \$19,500 of this shall be for three new positions at \$6,500 each and \$15,000 for increases in salary for 14 full-time employees].

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1975.
