(c) (1) The Sheriff of Anne Arundel County shall receive a salary of \$17,500. In addition to his salary, the Sheriff shall receive [\$145,000] [[\$154,000]] \$157,000 annually to be used for salaries of deputies and any necessary clerical assistants[; \$19,500 of this shall be for three new positions at \$6,500 each and \$15,000 for increases in salary for 14 full-time employees].
