BE IT FURTHER ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Section 1-1(c) of the Code of the Washington Suburban Sanitary District (1969 Edition, as amended), being also Section 86-1-1(c) of Article 16 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Montgomery County (1972 Edition and 1973 Supplement, as amended), being also Section 83-57[[(a)]] (c) of Article 17 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Prince George's County (1963 Edition and 1967 Supplement, as amended) be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted with amendments to read as follows:
