CHAPTER 505

(House Bill 1475)

AN ACT concerning

St. Mary's County - Classified Service System

FOR the purpose of [[eliminating the requirement]] requiring that minimum salary scales in St. Mary's County be [[equal to]] not less than the State minimum; providing that the County Commissioners determine certain matters relating to the classified service system; and relating generally to the classified service system in St. Mary's County.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Sections 10(2), 14(c) and 15(a) of the Public Local Laws of St. Mary's County being Article 19 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1965 Edition and 1974 Supplement, as amended) be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:
