Upon designation of the general appraisers, the register shall issue a warrant authorizing and directing them jointly to appraise all property of the estate of the decedent required to be independently appraised but not specially appraised under §7-202(c). If an appraiser shall fail to act, the register shall make a new designation and issue a new warrant upon application by the personal representative.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1975.
