CHAPTER 522

(House Bill 972)

AN ACT concerning

Antitrust - Permitted Conduct

FOR the purpose of correcting an error relating to the applicability of certain statutory defenses and permitted conduct under the State antitrust laws and conforming their applicability to that contained in the federal statutes dealing with similar matters.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Section 11-204(b) of Article - Commercial Law, of the Annotated Code of Maryland (As enacted by Chapter \_\_\_\_ (H.B. 26) of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1975) be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

Article - Commercial Law

11-204.

(b) Conduct not prohibited.

[This] SUBSECTIONS (A) (3) THROUGH (A) (6) OF THIS section [does] DO not prevent:

(1) Differentials which make only due allowance for differences in the cost of manufacture, sale, or delivery resulting from the differing methods or
