(h)] The commission [shall have the power to] MAY:

(1) Investigate and assemble information pertinent to the economic resources and industrial opportunities of the county.

(2) [Encourage location of new industrial enterprises in the county and expansion of present enterprises.] COOPERATE WITH, OFFER ASSISTANCE TO AND ENCOURAGE THE EXPANSION OF EXISTING BUSINESSES AND INDUSTRIES AND ACTIVELY WORK FOR THE LOCATION OF NEW BUSINESSES AND INDUSTRIES COMPATIBLE WITH THE RESOURCES AND ENVIRONMENT OF ST. MARY'S COUNTY.

(3) Encourage development of recreational areas and encourage tourist business in the county, making the public aware of the county's historical background and progress.

(4) Disseminate information in the interest of industrial development by publication, advertising and other means.

(5) Cooperate with any federal, state, local agency, board or commission including the Economic Development Commission of Maryland, in the furtherance of its purposes.

(6) Cooperate with any interested private concern, civic organization or subdivision thereof in furtherance of its purposes.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1975.
