

Article 26 of this Code and Chapter 900 of the Maryland Rules of Procedure. Any child who has been determined in need of care or treatment within the provisions of §§ 51 through 90, inclusive, of Article 26 of this Code shall remain under the continuing jurisdiction of the court in which his case was heard until that court finally terminates jurisdiction.]

[[SECTION 5. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section 1-503(a) of Article - Courts and Judicial Proceedings, of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1974 Volume and 1974 Supplement) be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

Article - Courts and Judicial Proceedings

1-503. Number of judges.

(a) In each county in the first seven judicial circuits there shall be the number of resident judges of the Circuit Court set forth below, including the judge or judges provided for by the Constitution:
