(12) District 12-3

SECTION 7. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Sections 1 through 5 of this Act shall take effect June 1, 1975. Section 6 shall take effect upon the day following the first day after June 1, 1975, in which two vacancies shall exist in the office of District Court judge for District 6.11

SECTION 5. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1975.

(House Bill 572)

AN ACT concerning

Medical Scholarships and Residencies

[[FOR the purpose of increasing the amount of individual scholarship awarded under the program of scholarships to the School of Medicine of the University of Maryland; changing the conditions of eligibility for receiving such scholarships;]]

FOR the purpose of changing the conditions of eligibility for receiving scholarships awarded under the program of scholarships to the School of Medicine of the University of Maryland; defining State health service: clarifying language: creating a Maryland Pamily Practice Residency Program to for residents training in financial support accredited family practice residency programs in Maryland; establishing conditions of eligibility for receiving such support; and relating generally to the Medical Scholarship Program and the Maryland Pamily Practice Residency Program.

Article 77A - Higher Education Section 61(a), (c) and (e) Annotated Code of Maryland (1969 Replacement Volume and 1974 Supplement)
