

THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES AND OTHER ELIGIBLE STATE AGENCIES AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT BODIES. THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES SHALL REPORT TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY ALL RECEIPTS AND DISBURSEMENTS OF THESE FUNDS BEGINNING ON JULY 1, 1975 AND ON EACH JULY 1 THEREAFTER.]]

SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1975.

CHAPTER 565

(Senate Bill 210)

AN ACT concerning

Salvaged Motor Vehicles

FOR the purpose of specifying certain procedures concerning motor vehicles subject to total loss insurance settlements [[and]] and creating an exception to the applicability of the excise tax on those vehicles[[, and relating to titles of rebuilt and restored vehicles]].

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That new Sections 3-113(f) and 3-506 be and they are hereby added to Article 66 1/2 - Vehicle Laws, of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1970 Replacement Volume and 1974 Supplement) to read as follows:
