

Article 66 1/2 - Vehicle Laws
 Section 3-505

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Section 3-505 of Article 66 1/2 - Vehicle Laws, of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1970 Replacement Volume and 1974 Supplement) be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

Article 66 1/2 - Vehicle Laws

3-505.

[[(A)]] Any [person who scraps, dismantles, or destroys a vehicle and any person who purchases a vehicle as scrap or to be dismantled or destroyed] OWNER WHO SELLS OR ASSIGNS HIS INTEREST IN A VEHICLE TO BE SCRAPPED, DISHANTLED OR DESTROYED shall immediately [cause] MAIL OR DELIVER the registration card and license plates [to be mailed or delivered] to the [Department] MOTOR VEHICLE ADMINISTRATION for cancellation unless the registration plates are transferred to another vehicle pursuant to this subtitle.

[[(B) THE PURCHASER OR ASSIGNEE OF THE MOTOR VEHICLE SHALL SURRENDER IMMEDIATELY THE REGISTRATION CARD AND LICENSE PLATES TO THE ADMINISTRATION IF THE PREVIOUS OWNER FAILS TO DO SO.]]

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1975.
