

INVESTMENT PURPOSES. NOTWITHSTANDING ANY PROVISIONS OF LAW TO THE CONTRARY, NO LEASE MADE BY THE TRUST IS SUBJECT TO REDEMPTION AT THE OPTION OF THE TENANT, UNLESS THERE IS AN EXPRESS PROVISION TO THAT EFFECT IN THE LEASE.

NOTHING CONTAINED IN THIS SUBTITLE MAY BE CONSTRUED TO LIMIT THE POWER OR ACTIVITY OF ANY AGENCY OF THIS STATE, ANY OF ITS SUBDIVISIONS, OR ANY PRIVATE AGENCY OR PERSON INTERESTED IN THE VETERANS WITHIN THIS STATE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1975.

AN ACT concerning

Workmen's Compensation - Volunteer [[Firemen and]]
Rescue Squadmen
