[[7-7B16]] 7-6A16. TRANSFER OF PERMIT.

- WHEN ONE OPERATOR SUCCEEDS TO THE INTEREST ANOTHER IN ANY UNCOMPLETED MINING OPERATION BY VIRTUE OF A SALE, LEASE, ASSIGNMENT, OR OTHERWISE, THE DEPARTMENT RELEASE THE FIRST OPERATOR FROM ALL LIABILITIES IMPOSED UPON HIM BY THIS SUBTITLE WITH REFERENCE TO THE OPERATION AND TRANSFER THE PERMIT TO THE SUCCESSOR OPERATOR, IF BOTH OPERATORS HAVE COMPLIED WITH REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SUBTITLE AND THE SUCCESSOR OPERATOR ASSUMES THE DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE FIRST OPERATOR WITH REFERENCE TO RECLAMATION OF THE LAND ACCORDING TO THE AUTHORIZED MINING AND RECLAMATION POSTS SUITABLE BOND OR OTHER SECURITY REQUIRED BY AND \$[[7-7B18]] 7-6A20.
