

YEARS PRIOR TO THE APPOINTMENT. TWO MEMBERS SHALL BE REPRESENTATIVES OF THE PUBLIC. THE GOVERNOR SHALL DESIGNATE THE PRESIDENT, TREASURER, AND SECRETARY OF THE BOARD.

(B) THE FIRST MEETING OF THE BOARD SHALL BE HELD WITHIN THIRTY DAYS AFTER APPOINTMENT.

(C) EACH MEMBER OF THE BOARD SHALL RECEIVE A PER DIEM COMPENSATION FOR EACH DAY NECESSARILY AND ACTUALLY ENGAGED IN THE PERFORMANCE OF HIS DUTIES, AND REIMBURSEMENT FOR HIS REASONABLE EXPENSES INCURRED IN THE PERFORMANCE OF HIS OFFICIAL DUTIES, ALL AS PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET.

(D) THE EXERCISE OR PERFORMANCE OF ALL POWERS, AUTHORITY, DUTIES, AND FUNCTIONS VESTED IN THE BOARD OF BARBER EXAMINERS BY THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBTITLE, IS SUBJECT TO THE AUTHORITY OF THE SECRETARY OF LICENSING AND REGULATION AS SET FORTH IN ARTICLE 41 OF THIS CODE, OR ELSEWHERE IN THE LAWS OF THIS STATE.

CHAPTER 583

(Senate Bill 347)

AN ACT concerning

District Court - Fines, Penalties, and Forfeitures

FOR the purpose of providing that fines, penalties, and forfeitures relating to violations of local housing, building, fire, health, or sanitation codes shall be remitted to local governments.
