- (A) THE BOARD SHALL HAVE THE FOLLOWING POWERS AND DUTIES:
- (1) TO ADOPT AND REVISE STANDARDS OF NURSING PRACTICE PERFORMED BY REGISTERED AND LICENSED PRACTICAL NURSES.
- (2) TO DETERMINE WHEN THE PERFORMANCE OF ADDITIONAL ACTS, UNDER EMERGENCY OR OTHER CONDITIONS REQUIRING EDUCATION AND CLINICAL EXPERIENCE AS RECOGNIZED BY THE MEDICAL AND NURSING PROFESSIONS, ARE PROPER TO BE PERFORMED BY REGISTERED NURSES OR LICENSED PRACTICAL NURSES WITHIN WHATEVER CONDITIONS ARE AUTHORIZED BY THE BOARD.
