

(D) THE PERFORMANCE OF SELECTED ACTS OF NURSING AS AUTHORIZED IN SECTION 291 (D) OF THIS ARTICLE.

(E) CARE OF THE ILL, INJURED OR INFIRM BY A CHRISTIAN SCIENCE NURSE, LISTED IN THE CHRISTIAN SCIENCE JOURNAL, PROVIDED THAT PERSON ADMINISTERS NO MEDICINES OR DRUGS, INTERNAL OR EXTERNAL.

301.

(A) IT IS A MISDEMEANOR TO:

(1) SELL OR FRAUDULENTLY OBTAIN OR FURNISH ANY NURSING DIPLOMA, LICENSE, RENEWAL OR RECORD, OR AID OR ABET THE ACTIVITY.

(2) PRACTICE NURSING AS DEFINED BY THIS SUBTITLE UNDER COLOR OF ANY DIPLOMA, LICENSE, OR RECORD ILLEGALLY OR FRAUDULENTLY OBTAINED OR SIGNED OR ISSUED UNLAWFULLY OR UNDER FRAUDULENT REPRESENTATION.

(3) PRACTICE REGISTERED NURSING OR LICENSED PRACTICAL NURSING AS DEFINED BY THIS SUBTITLE UNLESS DULY LICENSED TO DO SO UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBTITLE.

(4) USE IN CONNECTION WITH THE PERSON'S NAME THE DESIGNATION "NURSE" (EXCEPT AS AUTHORIZED IN SECTION 300 (E) OF THIS ARTICLE) OR ANY OTHER DESIGNATION TENDING TO IMPLY THAT THE PERSON IS A LICENSED REGISTERED NURSE OR A LICENSED PRACTICAL NURSE UNLESS LICENSED TO PRACTICE UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBTITLE.

(5) PRACTICE REGISTERED NURSING OR LICENSED PRACTICAL NURSING DURING THE TIME A LICENSE ISSUED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBTITLE HAS LAPSED, BEEN SUSPENDED OR BEEN REVOKED.

(6) KNOWINGLY EMPLOY UNLICENSED PERSONS IN THE PRACTICE OF NURSING.

(7) FAIL TO REPORT AS REQUIRED IN SECTION 294 (A) (17).

(B) ANY PERSON, INSTITUTION OR AGENCY CONVICTED OF VIOLATING THIS SUBTITLE SHALL BE FINED NOT MORE THAN \$100 FOR THE FIRST OFFENSE. EACH SUBSEQUENT OFFENSE IS PUNISHABLE BY A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$500 OR BY IMPRISONMENT OF NOT MORE THAN SIX MONTHS OR BY BOTH THE FINE AND IMPRISONMENT.
