

TRAVELED WAY. COMPENSATION MAY BE PAID ONLY FOR THE FOLLOWING:

(1) THE TAKING FROM THE OWNER OF THE OUTDOOR ADVERTISING SIGN OF ALL RIGHT, TITLE, LEASEHOLD, AND INTEREST THEREIN.

(2) THE TAKING FROM THE OWNER OF THE LAND ON WHICH THE OUTDOOR ADVERTISING SIGN IS LOCATED, OF THE RIGHT TO ERECT AND MAINTAIN THE OUTDOOR ADVERTISING SIGN THEREON.

233B.

THE STATE HIGHWAY ADMINISTRATION SHALL NOT BE REQUIRED TO EXPEND ANY FUNDS PURSUANT TO THE HIGHWAY BEAUTIFICATION ACT OF 1965 AND THE FEDERAL-AID HIGHWAY AMENDMENT OF 1974, AND AMENDMENTS THERETO, UNTIL APPROPRIATE FEDERAL MATCHING FUNDS ARE AVAILABLE UNDER SUCH ACTS.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1975.

CHAPTER 626

(Senate Bill 1012)

AN ACT concerning

Frederick County - Carnivals, Bazaars or Raffles

FOR the purpose of providing that in Frederick County certain organizations conducting or holding a carnival, bazaar or raffle shall be exempt from the provisions generally relating to "Gaming"; limiting the use of those proceeds; providing that the carnival, bazaar or raffle shall be managed by the organization's members personally; and clarifying language.
