

FOR the purpose of changing the expiration date of all alcoholic beverage licenses in Garrett County.

BY adding to

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages
Section 68(d-1)
Annotated Code of Maryland
(1968 Replacement Volume and 1974 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That new Section 68(d-1) be and it is hereby added to Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages, of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1968 Replacement Volume and 1974 Supplement) to read as follows:

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

68.

(D-1) IN GARRETT COUNTY, THE CLERK OF THE [[COUNTY]] COURT OF THE COUNTY MAY ISSUE NEW LICENSES FOR THE ENSUING YEAR AS PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION AT ANY TIME BETWEEN JUNE 15 AND JULY 1 OF EACH AND EVERY YEAR, BUT ALL LICENSES SHALL BE DATED JULY 1. DURING THE FIRST CALENDAR YEAR, THE COUNTY LIQUOR CONTROL BOARD SHALL PRORATE ALL CLASS LICENSES FOR A PERIOD OF 14 MONTHS. THEREAFTER, [[LICENSEES]] LICENSES SHALL BE PRORATED ON A 12 MONTH BASIS.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1975.
