SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section 5.2(P)(1) of Chapter 179 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1972, be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

Chapter 179

5.2(P).

(1) [Purchase of] Poplar Hill Mansion, Salisbury [, contingent upon the community assuming responsibility for all costs of major alterations, repairs and operations] RESTORATION AND RENOVATION OF POPLAR HILL MANSION, SALISBURY, AND THE PURCHASE OF LAND ADJOINING POPLAR HILL MANSION, SALISBURY, CONTINGENT UPON THE COMMUNITY ASSUMING RESPONSIBILITY FOR ALL COSTS OF REPAIRS, MAINTENANCE, AND OPERATIONS AND FOR ALL COSTS OF MAJOR ALTERATIONS NOT PROVIDED FOR BY THIS APPROPRIATION.....78,000

SECTION [[2]] 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1975.

AN ACT concerning

Dorchester County
