CHAPTER 653

(House Bill 169)

AN ACT concerning

State Police Retirement System - Survivor Benefits

FOR the purpose of providing certain survivor benefits to members of the family of certain retired state policemen in order to correct an omission in Chapter 232 of the Acts of 1972 relating to state policemen who retire on ordinary disability.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Sections 53(4) and (11) of Article 88B - State Police, of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1969 Replacement Volume and 1974 Supplement) be and they are hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

Article 88B - State Police

53.

(4) (a) Upon retirement for ordinary disability a member shall receive a service retirement allowance if
