HOWEVER, IN PUBLIC VOCATIONAL SCHOOL COURSES OF COSMETOLOGY, COMPLETION OF THE PRESCRIBED 1500 HOURS OF TRAINING SHALL BE ACCOMPLISHED WITHIN A PERIOD OF TIME DETERMINED BY THE BOARDS OF EDUCATION OF THE SEVERAL COUNTIES AND THE BOARD OF SCHOOL COMMISSIONERS OF BALTIMORE CITY.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1975.

CHAPTER 663

(House Bill 228)

AN ACT concerning

Cosmetologists - Student Practice

FOR the purpose of permitting certain students in schools of cosmetology to practice beauty culture on persons [[confined to or in private or public hospitals and nursing homes and State and local correctional]] in certain facilities, subject to certain conditions, and relating generally to student practice of cosmetology.
