(f) Any fraud or misrepresentation in the application for or use of a special identification card issued under this section is a misdemeanor, punishable by [a fine of not more than \$500.00 or by imprisonment of 90 days, or both. The penalties provided by this subsection are in lieu of] the penalties imposed by § 17-101 of this article.

- (b) Every person convicted of a misdemeanor for the [violations] VIOLATION of any provision of this Article shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$500, except that:
- (i) Every person who is convicted of a violation of \S 6-303, \S 11-904 or of subsection (a) of \S 11-902 shall be punished by imprisonment for not more than one year or by fine of not more than \$1,000 or both fine and imprisonment.
