SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That new Section 19(g) be and it is hereby added to Article 101 — Workmen's Compensation, of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1964 Replacement Volume and 1974 Supplement) to read as follows:

Article 101 - Workmen's Compensation

19.

- (G) WHEN ANY POLICY OF INSURANCE COVERING THE LIABILITY OF THE EMPLOYER FOR COMPENSATION PROVIDED FOR IN THIS ARTICLE IS RENEWED, THE INSURANCE CARRIER SHALL FURNISH THE EMPLOYER CONSPICUOUS WRITTEN NOTICE OF THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION CONCERNING THE EMPLOYMENT OF MINORS:
- (1) ANY MINOR EMPLOYEE OF THE INSURED EMPLOYER MUST POSSESS A WORK PERMIT AS REQUIRED BY STATE LAW.
- (2) ALL COMPENSATION AND DEATH BENEFITS PROVIDED UNDER THE WORKHEN'S COMPENSATION LAWS [[ARE]] MAY BE DOUBLED IN THE CASE OF ANY MINOR EMPLOYED WITHOUT A WORK PERMIT (ARTICLE 101, SECTION 47 OF THE ANNOTATED CODE).
- (3) THE EMPLOYER IS SOLELY LIABLE FOR THE INCREASED AMOUNT OF COMPENSATION OR DEATH BENEFITS FOR A MINOR EMPLOYEE SHO DOES NOT POSSESS A WORK PERMIT (ARTICLE 101, SECTION 47 OF THE ANNOTATED CODE).

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1975.

(House Bill 510)

AN ACT concerning

State Agencies - Reimbursement for Expenses

FOR the purpose of providing that certain members and other agents of certain State agencies, boards and commissions shall be reimbursed for expenses incurred in the actual performance of their duties
