SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Section 99 of Article 77 - Public Education, of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1969 Replacement Volume and 1974 Supplement) be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

Article 77 - Public Education

It shall be the duty of the boards of education of the several counties and Baltimore City to furnish to their respective health departments any information they may receive as to children with mental, physical, and/or emotional handicaps living within the boundaries of their school system.
