duties IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE STANDARD TRAVEL REGULATIONS, when authorized and approved by the Commission.

The Maryland Veterans Commission, subject to the provisions of Article 41, § 205C of this Code, shall make such rules and regulations as it may deem necessary for administration and disbursement of such veterans relief funds as are provided for in the budget, and the State Service Officer, hereinafter provided for, shall approve all bills and vouchers before payment by the Comptroller.

There shall be a committee of nine persons, to be known as the advisory Maryland veterans committee, composed of the current department commanders, respectively, of the American Legion, the Marine Corps League, the Veterans of Foreign Wars, the Disabled American Veterans, the Spanish-American War Veterans, the World War I Veterans, the Catholic War Veterans, the Jewish War Veterans and the designee of the fleet Reserve Association as determined by its board of directors of Branch 6. The members of such committee shall serve without pay and the committee shall advise and work with the Maryland Veterans Commission in the duties imposed upon them by this subtitle, but shall not be members of the Commission.

SECTION 7. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1975.

CHAPTER 727

(House Bill 863)

AN ACT concerning

State Agencies - Reimbursement for Expenses

FOR the purpose of providing that certain members and other agents of certain State agencies, boards and commissions shall be reimbursed for expenses incurred in the actual performance of their duties in accordance with the Standard Travel Regulations as promulgated by the Department of Public Works.
