shall file with the Comptroller a bond in the minimum penalty of [[five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00)]] \$5,000. Such a bond shall be in such form as may be approved by the Comptroller, shall be executed by a surety company duly authorized to do business in this State, and shall conditioned upon the payment of all taxes, penalties and interest imposed by this article upon the sale or wines and liquors, and generally upon the delivery of faithful compliance with the provisions of this article. [In the event that, pursuant to the provisions of §138 of subtitle, certificates or stamps denoting payment of taxes on alcoholic beverages except beer furnished by the Comptroller on credit in an amount in excess five thousand dollars (\$5,000). ο£ manufacturer or wholesaler shall file an additional bond in the same manner and form in an amount not less amount of such excess.] A MANUFACTURER, WHOLESALER OR DISPENSARY SHALL FILE [[AN ADDITIONAL]] A BOND IN THE MANNEL AND FORM IN AN AMOUNT DOUBLE THE AMOUNT OF ITS LARGEST MONTHLY TAX LIABILITY IN THE PROCEEDING CALENDAR YEAR LESS \$5,000. IN THE EVENT THAT THIS INFORMATION FOR A CALENDAR YEAR IS NOT AVAILABLE OR CANNOT BE MADE, THE AMOUNT OF THE BOND SHALL BE SET BY THE COMPTROLLER. PURSUANT TO THE PROVISION OF SECTION OF THIS ARTICLE, IF CERTIFICATES OR STAMPS DENOTING THE AMOUNT OF TAXES ON ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES EXCEPT WINE BY THE COMPTROLLER, AND ARE FURNISHED MANUFACTURER. DISPENSARY OR WHOLESALER RECEIVING STAMPS CERTIFICATES SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR AND PAY ACCOUNTABLE TO THE TAX VALUE FOR ANY LOSS UNVERIFIED DESTRUCTION. THE COMPTROLLER MAY LIMIT THE DISBURSEMENT OF EXCESSIVE AMOUNTS OF STAMPS OR CERTIFICATES. MAY REQUIRE PROOF OF NEED AND MAY PROMULGATE SUCH REGULATIONS AS MAY BE NECESSARY TO INSURE ADEQUATE AVAILABILITY OF STAMPS AND CERTIFICATES TO PREVENT ANY ABUSE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1975.
