(D) AT THE DISCRETION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF EMPLOYMENT AND SOCIAL SERVICES, SUPPORT MAY BE CONTINUED [[AT THE APPROPRIATE MONTHLY RATE]] TO PARENTS WHO ADOPT POSTER CHILDREN. THE AMOUNT AND DURATION OF ADOPTION SUBSIDY PAYMENTS MAY VARY ACCORDING TO THE SPECIAL NEEDS OF THE CHILD AND THE INCOME OF THE ADOPTING PARENT AND MAY INCLUDE MAINTENANCE COSTS, MEDICAL, DENTAL, AND SURGICAL EXPENSES, PSYCHIATRIC AND PSYCHOLOGICAL EXPENSES, AND OTHER COSTS NECESSARY FOR THE CHILD'S CARE AND WELL BEING.
