AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the SECTION 2. aforegoing Article hereby proposed as an amendment to the Constitution of Maryland, at the next general election to be held in this State in November, 1976, shall be submitted to the legal and qualified voters thereof for their adoption or rejection in pursuance of directions contained in Article XIV of the Constitution of this State. At that general election, the vote on this proposed amendment to the Constitution shall be by ballot, and upon each ballot there shall be printed the words "For the Constitutional [[Amendments]] Amendment" "Against the Constitutional [[Amendments]] and Amendment," as now provided by law. Immediately after the election, all returns shall be made to the Governor of the vote for and against the proposed amendment, as directed by Article XIV of the Constitution, and further proceedings had in accordance with Article XIV.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
