SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Sections 8(1) and 11(m) of Article 2B — Alcoholic Beverages, of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1968 Replacement Volume and 1974 Supplement) be and they are hereby repealed and re—enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

8.

(1) In St. Mary's County the annual license fee for a Class A beer license is [\$150] [[\$75]] \$150.

11.

(m) In St. Mary's County the annual fee for [such a] THIS license [shall be fifty dollars (\$50.00)] IS \$100. The fee [shall be seventy-five dollars (\$75.00)] IS \$150 for a Special Class D (on sale) beer license entitling the holder to sell beer on Sunday.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1975.
