

ON OR BEFORE FEBRUARY 1 OF EACH YEAR, THE HOLDER OF AN INSTALLMENT SALES AGREEMENT SHALL INFORM THE BUYER IN WRITING OF THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF FINANCE CHARGES PAID BY OR ON BEHALF OF THE BUYER DURING THE PRECEDING CALENDAR YEAR.]]

THE BUYER UNDER AN OPEN END RETAIL CREDIT ACCOUNT MAY REQUEST IN WRITING, NOT MORE FREQUENTLY THAN ONCE EACH YEAR, THAT THE HOLDER OF THE ACCOUNT INFORM THE BUYER OF THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF FINANCE CHARGES ASSESSED ON THE ACCOUNT DURING THE PRECEDING CALENDAR YEAR AND THE HOLDER SHALL SO ADVISE THE BUYER IN WRITING WITHIN 30 DAYS OF THE REQUEST.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1975.

CHAPTER 783

(House Bill 1311)

AN ACT concerning

Elections - Certificates of Candidacy

FOR the purpose of permitting certain certificates of candidacy to be filed by certified mail before a certain date.

BY adding to

Article 33 - Election Code
Section 4A-2(e)
Annotated Code of Maryland
(1971 Replacement Volume and 1974 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That new Section 4A-2(e) be and it is hereby added to Article 33 - Election Code, of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1971 Replacement Volume and 1974 Supplement) to read as follows:
