CHAPTER 820

(House Bill 1594)

AN ACT concerning

Pensions - Judges

FOR the purpose of providing that a judge receives a minimum pension upon retirement for disability.

BY adding to

Article 73B — Pensions
Section 56(i)
Annotated Code of Maryland
(1970 Replacement Volume and 1974 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That new Section 56(i) be and it is hereby added to Article 73B — Pensions, of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1970 Replacement Volume and 1974 Supplement) to read as follows:

Article 73B - Pensions

56.

(I) [[UPON RETIREMENT, A JUDGE SHALL RECEIVE A PENSION OF NO LESS THAN ONE THIRD OF THE JUDGE'S ANNUAL SALARY]] A JUDGE WHO RETIRES DUE TO DISABILITY DURING PERIOD JULY 1, 1975, THROUGH JULY 1, 1977, SHALL BE ENTITLED TO A PENSION EQUIVALENT TO ONE—THIRD OF THE ANNUAL SALARY FOR JUDGES OF THAT COURT IN EFFECT AS OF THE DATE OF RETIREMENT.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1975.
