ARE IN CONFORMITY WITH ANY CONDITIONS THAT A SENTENCING OR ADMINISTRATIVE JUDGE MAY IMPOSE IN A PARTICULAR CASE 1 THE EVENT OF ANY VIOLATION OF TRUST OR CONDITIONS PRESCRIBED BY THE [[SHERIFF]] COUNTY DETENTION CENTER **ADMINISTRATOR** OF PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY FOR PRISONER'S CONDUCT DURING HIS PARTICIPATION IN ANY EDUCATIONAL OR VOCATIONAL PROGRAM THE PRISONER MAY REMOVED FROM SAID PROGRAM BY THE COUNTY DETENTION CENTER ADMINISTRATOR WITH NOTICE TO THE SENTENCING JUDGE ANY EARNED DIMUNITION MAY BE CANCELLED AFTER ADMINISTRATION HEARING HAS TAKEN PLACE. If FAILURE OF A PRISONER: TO COMPLY WITH THE AUTHORIZATION FOR LEAVE TO PARTICIPATE IN ANY OF THESE PROGRAMS SHALL BE CONSIDERED A VIOLATION OF THE PROVISION OF SECTION 139 OF THIS ARTICLE. 11

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1975.
