EDUCATIONAL OR VOCATIONAL PROGRAM THE PRISONER MAY BE
REMOVED FROM SAID PROGRAM BY THE COUNTY DETENTION CENTER
ADMINISTRATOR WITH NOTICE TO THE SENTENCING JUDGE AND
ANY EARNED DIMUNITION MAY BE CANCELLED AFTER AN
ADMINISTRATION HEARING HAS TAKEN PLACE. [[FAILURE OF A
PRISONER TO COMPLY WITH THE AUTHORIZATION FOR LEAVE TO
PARTICIPATE IN ANY OF THESE PROGRAMS SHALL BE CONSIDERED
A VIOLATION OF THE PROVISION OF SECTION 139 OF THIS
ARTICLE.]]

AN ACT concerning

Prince George's County - Suspended Sentence

FOR the purpose of altering the provision to allow the Judges more discretion in the time and dates to be served.

Article 27 - Crimes and Punishments

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Section 639 of Article 27 - Crimes and Punishments, of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1971 Replacement Volume and 1974 Supplement) be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:
