CHAPTER 851

(Senate Bill 996)

AN ACT concerning

Oil Disaster Containment - Clean-Up and Contingency Fund

FOR the purpose of abolishing the fixed monetary ceiling on the Maryland Oil Disaster Containment, Clean-up, and Contingency Fund; [[abolishing]] providing for the abatement of the collection of certain license fees if a fixed ceiling is attained [[; and authorizing the Department of Natural Resources temporarily to abate or reduce certain license fees if the Oil Disaster Containment, Clean-up and Contingency Fund attains a certain size]].
