clearly, in the case of laying out, opening or extending any street, square, lane or alley, the length or width of [such] THE street, square, lane or alley, or part thereof to be laid out, opened or extended, and, in the case widening or straightening shall set forth clearly both the present and the intended width, and also the any street, lane or alley or part thereof intended to be widened or straightened, and in case of closing shall forth clearly the length and width of the street, lane or alley, or any part thereof, intended to and notice 1. NOTICE shall also be given by closed[: filing, [in the office of the Commissioners for Opening Streets,] WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS on or before the first day of [such] THE publication, a map scale, not smaller than [fifty] 50 feet to the inch, prepared by some competent surveyor, whose name shall signed to the same, which, in case of laying out, opening, extending, widening or straightening, shall show the course and the lines of the projected improvement, also the lots and buildings thereon which shall be taken or destroyed, in whole or in part, and which, the case of closing shall show the street, lane or alley, or part thereof, intended to be closed, and also the abutting lots and improvements thereon. [It shall be the duty of the Commissioners THE DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS SHALL [to] endorse on [said] THE map [their names,] HIS NAME, with the date of it being filed in [their] HIS office, and [to] keep the [said] map where the public may have access to it[, whenever 1. WHENEVER [said] THE map may be needed for the purpose of being shown at any meeting of the City Council, or of committee thereof, [they] HE may, on the written order or request of the President of the City Council, or of the chairman of such committee, and, on obtaining his receipt therefor, allow the [said] map to be taken from [their] office for that purpose, to be returned on the following day. At any time before the final passage of [said] THE ordinance, [said] THE map and [said] THE ordinance may be amended[, provided such] IF amendment [shall] DOES not substantially depart from the published notice, so as to substantially affect parties who would not be warned by [such] THE notice.

Before [any commissioners appointed by any ordinance of said corporation, under sections 21-12 and 21-13,] THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS shall proceed [to the performance of their duty, they] UNDER SECTIONS 21-12 AND 21-13 TO PERFORM ITS DUTY, IT shall give notice in at least two of the daily newspapers in the City of Baltimore of the object of the ordinance under which [they propose] IT PROPOSES to act, at least ten days before the time of [their] THE first meeting to execute
