

LICENSES SHALL BE FROM 6 O'CLOCK A.M. TO 12 O'CLOCK MIDNIGHT, ON EVERY DAY EXCEPT SUNDAYS.

80.

(A) EXCEPT IN PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY, [The] THE hours during which alcoholic beverages may be sold or delivered to retail license holders by holders of manufacturers' licenses shall be from 6 o'clock a.m. to 12 o'clock midnight, on every day except Sundays and election days.

(B) IN PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY THE HOURS DURING WHICH ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES MAY BE SOLD OR DELIVERED TO RETAIL LICENSE HOLDERS BY HOLDERS OF WHOLESALERS' LICENSES SHALL BE FROM 6 O'CLOCK A.M. TO 12 O'CLOCK MIDNIGHT, ON EVERY DAY EXCEPT SUNDAYS.

(b) The holder of any license issued under the provisions of this article shall be permitted to exercise all of the privileges conferred by such a license on the day of any municipal election in any of the incorporated towns of [[Prince George's County or in Caroline County AND IN PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY ON THE DAY OF ANY SPECIAL, PRIMARY OR GENERAL ELECTION]] CAROLINE COUNTY.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That new Section 88(d) be and it is hereby added to Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages, of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1968 Replacement Volume and 1974 Supplement) to read as follows:

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

(D) IN PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY, THE HOLDER OF ANY LICENSE ISSUED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ARTICLE IS PERMITTED TO EXERCISE ALL OF THE PRIVILEGES CONFERRED BY THAT LICENSE ON THE DAY OF ANY ELECTION IN PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY.

SECTION [[2]] 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1975.
