CHAPTER 874

(House Bill 1322)

AN ACT concerning

Cecil County - Sheriff's Office

FOR the purpose of specifying the number of deputies the Sheriff of Cecil County may appoint or hire; increasing the salaries of certain deputies; making certain changes in terminology; specifying the number of automobiles the Cecil County Commissioner shall furnish the Sheriff's office, and specifying when they shall be replaced[.]; and providing that the sheriff may appoint additional deputy sheriffs after obtaining the approval of the County Commissioners of Cecil County.

BY repealing and re-enacting, with amendments,

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Sections 2-309 (i) (1) and (2) of Article - Courts and Judicial Proceedings, of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1974 Volume and 1974 Supplement) be and they are hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

Article - Courts and Judicial Proceedings

2-309.

(i) (1) The Sheriff of Cecil County shall receive a salary of \$12,500 and free lodging for himself and his family at the jail or \$1,500 per year. The Sheriff shall appoint [[NOT LESS THAN nine]] 16 full-time deputy sheriffs, one as chief deputy and one as investigator. After the investigator has performed his duties, he shall assume the duties of a deputy. The starting salary of the chief deputy and investigator is [[\$8,000]] \$8,300
