

Howard County - Alcoholic Beverages

FOR the purpose of providing for the issuance of Class D beer and light wine licenses in Howard County; specifying an annual fee; altering the sequence of subsections by adding a new subsection; and clarifying language.

BY repealing and re-enacting, with amendments,

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages
Section 16(k)
Annotated Code of Maryland
(1968 Replacement Volume and 1974 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Section 16(k) of Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages, of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1968 Replacement Volume and 1974 Supplement) be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

16.

(k) IN HOWARD COUNTY, THE ANNUAL FEE FOR A CLASS D BEER AND LIGHT WINE LICENSE IS \$175.

(L) This section [shall] DOES not apply to the City of Annapolis nor to Calvert, Caroline, Charles, Dorchester, Frederick, Garrett, Harford, [Howard,] Kent, Queen Anne's, St. Mary's, Somerset, and Talbot counties, in all of which jurisdictions such licenses [shall] MAY not be issued.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1975.
