The remainder of the proceeds of such loan shall be credited on the books of the State Comptroller, to be expended as needed by the State, upon approval by the Board of Public Works, for the following needs, purposes and projects, and amounts listed below being intended to include Architects' and Engineers' fees where applicable:

Upon approval of an agreement to purchase the land and parking garage from Anne Arundel County at a price not to exceed \$5,600,000, the appropriation made by Chapter 195 of the Acts of 1973 providing \$1,000,000 as the State's share of acquisition and
