

that county, UPON RECOMMENDATION FROM THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE, may authorize [such] WHATEVER supplementary salary as may be deemed appropriate. For any member designated by Montgomery County to serve on a full-time basis, the County Council, with approval of the County Executive, may authorize [such] WHATEVER supplementary salary as may be appropriate. In the event the County Executive fails to approve a supplementary salary authorization by the Council [hereunder] within [thirty] 30 days, the Council [may], by an affirmative vote of five of its members, MAY authorize [such] THE supplementary salary notwithstanding the lack of approval of the County Executive. Any supplementary salary authorized [hereunder] IN THIS TITLE shall [also] be payable ALSO from the administrative tax collected by the Commission.

The [governing body] COUNTY EXECUTIVE OF PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE COUNTY COUNCIL, BY A VOTE OF A MAJORITY OF THE FULL COUNCIL, and the County Council of Montgomery County, subject to the approval of the County Executive as provided [herein] IN THIS TITLE, shall each designate a member for the position of chairman or vice-chairman. Upon designation by the Montgomery County Council, the name of the designee shall be delivered within three days to the Montgomery County Executive who within [thirty] 30 days thereafter shall either approve or disapprove the designation. In the event that the COUNTY Executive disapproves a designee, he shall return the name of the designee to the Council with the reasons for his disapproval stated in writing. The Council [may], by the affirmative vote of five of its members, MAY designate a member of the Commission for the position of chairman or vice-chairman over the disapproval of the County Executive. Any designation which has not been disapproved by the County Executive in [the] THIS manner [provided herein] shall be deemed to have been confirmed. The Commission shall elect a chairman and vice-chairman from those members designated as above. The chairman shall preside at meetings of the Commission and [shall] perform the other customary duties of [such] THE office. The vice-chairman shall preside in the absence of the chairman [and, in addition, shall be responsible for liaison between the Commission and its department of parks]. The chairman and the vice-chairman of the Commission also serve as chairmen of their respective county planning boards, as [hereinafter] CONSTITUTED in this [chapter constituted] ARTICLE.
